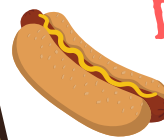
# SATURDAY JUNE 22ND, 2019 10AM TO 3PM

# 3 DOUBLE H RANCH

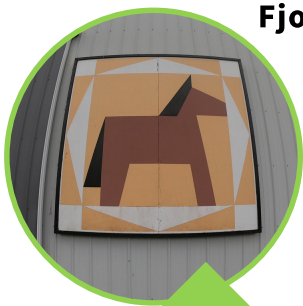

# 7 EAGLE BEND ALPACAS

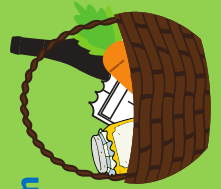

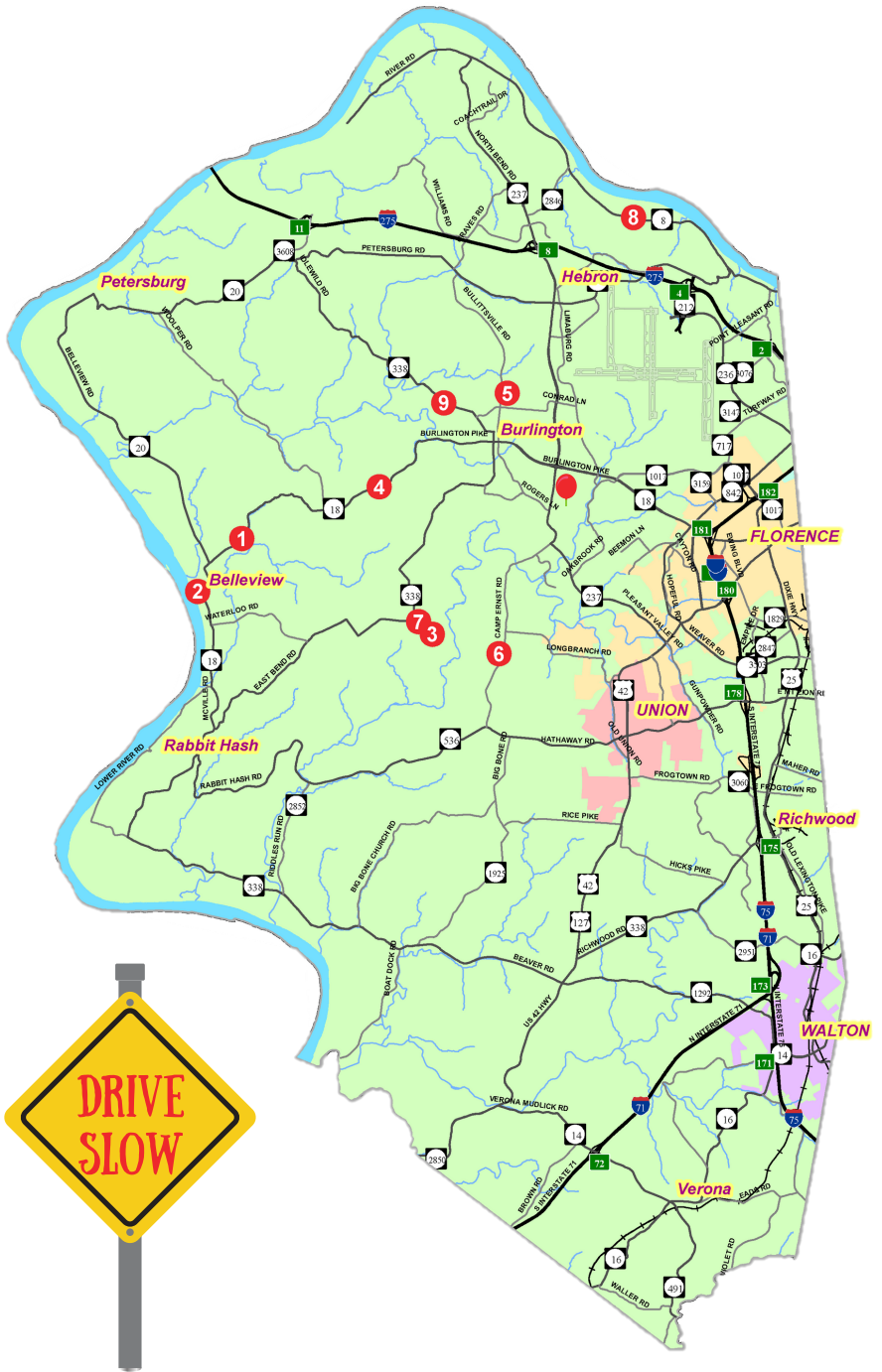
